



PARADE RULES

Important Information & Reminders

Thank you for your interest in the Annual Spryfield Santa Claus Parade. This year's parade will take place on the last Sunday of November, commencing at 2:00pm.

The Spryfield Santa Claus Parade does not charge an entrance fee. However, the organizers of the Parade ask that you consider donating a non-perishable food item(s) for our local food bank. Donations will be collected by our volunteers at the Marshaling area before the Parade starts.

The success of this community and family oriented event is due to your support. Here are the official rules, and some important reminders and notes for you and your organization to consider.

1. **There will be only one Santa Claus in the parade.** The Spryfield Santa Claus Parade Committee will determine on an annual basis which organization will provide Santa Claus each year.
2. **Vehicles in the parade will be required to show proof of insurance in the amount of \$2 million in coverage.**
3. **Participants should arrive at the Marshaling area on Punch Bowl Dr. at least one hour prior to the start time, large floats an hour and a half.**
4. **There is to be no throwing of candy or other objects to spectators from vehicles.** You are permitted to go to the parade sidelines and hand out candy or other items.
5. Please continue on the parade route at an even pace, not too slow and not too fast. Do not allow large gaps to form between you and the group behind or in front of you.
6. The parade will begin on Punch Bowl Drive and travel along the outbound lane of the Herring Cove Road, turn right onto Dentith Road at the lights, then left into the Spryfield Shopping Centre Parking lot, where the awards will be presented.
7. **Once in the parking lot at the Mall we ask that floats turn to the right and park as directed by the attendants.**
8. Parade judges will be wandering through the Marshaling area and will also be located on the parade route during the parade.
9. Last but not least, this is a community event for one and all, please remember those big smiles and have fun.
